

1) Where can I find the scholarship application?

2) How do I submit the application?

3) I submitted an application. How long will it take to hear back?

It typically takes about a week to hear back.

4) Is there an age requirement?

We ask that students be at least 5 or 6 years old.

5) How much do lessons cost?

Lessons don't cost anything--they are free!

6) Are instruments included with the scholarship?

Yes. Each scholarship recipient is awarded an instrument to borrow for as long as they are taking lessons. If you own an instrument already, we ask that you please use your own.

7) What instruments do you offer?

Currently, offer violin and ukulele lessons. We are also starting guitar lessons as soon as we find a teacher. If you are interested in taking guitar lessons, please let us know so we can put you on the wait list and inform you when we find a teacher.

8) Do you offer lessons or just scholarships? We don't meet the requirements for a scholarship, but we are still interested in lessons.

We only offer lessons to those who earn scholarships. If you are eligible for a scholarship, we encourage you to look elsewhere in your community for lessons.

9) What days and times are classes held?

Currently, there is one ukulele class on Saturdays at 1PM. We are forming new classes soon and they are likely to be either on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.

10) How often are classes held and how long are classes?

Our classes are held weekly and they are one hour long.

11) Where are the lessons located?

We have two locations. My First Piano is located on Gilbert and Southern and the address is 1818 E Southern Ave Suite 5. Mesa 85204. The church is located on Broadway and Stapley and the address is 1500 E 6th Ave, Mesa, AZ 85204.

12) How long/many lessons does the scholarship cover?

The scholarship covers lessons indefinitely.

13) Are lessons only offered during the school year?

No, lessons are offered both during the school year and over the summer.

14) I have multiple kids interested in lessons. Can apply more than one of them for the scholarship?

Yes, we welcome multiple applications from the same family to apply.

15) If I have more than one kid who wants lessons, do I fill out one application or multiple applications?

You must fill out a separate application for each child.

16) Is it okay if my kids are homeschooled?

Yes, you are welcome to apply your kids for scholarships.

17) We homeschool our kids and don't really have a report card- what would you like me to provide for that requirement?

You don't need to provide a report card. Instead, please provide a statement on any learning disabilities or problems that may disrupt a class (ADD etc.), if applicable.
